



INFORMATION SHEET FOR VISITORS OF WEYBROOK PARK GOLF CLUB

Weybrook Park Golf Club welcomes you and hopes you will have a most enjoyable day with us.

COURSE

The East course is a parkland course, with small undulating greens.

The West course is a downland course measuring over 6800 from the black tees. It opened in May 2021 and is maturing all the time. Please help us to protect the more sensitive areas with good course etiquette.

Buggy and trolley users – please use the paths wherever they are provided.

DO NOT – take your trolley or buggy onto tees or green fringes.

ESSENTIAL ETIQUETTE

RAKE BUNKERS

REPAIR PITCH MARKS

REPLACE DIVOTS

GOOD PACE OF PLAY

Keep up with the players in front.
Play READY GOLF. A 4 ball should take no more than 4 hrs 10 mins to complete 18 holes of the West course. 2 hrs is the maximum time for 9 holes on the East course.

PIN POSITIONS / COLOURED FLAGS

Red =Front

Yellow =Centre

White =Back

For more detailed course information/yardages, course planners are available from the Pro Shop.

FAIRWAY MARKERS

Coloured discs in the centre of the fairways and marker posts on the side indicate yardages to the centre of the green.

Red 100 | Yellow 150 | Blue 200

KEY LOCAL RULES

Large ground under repair & New Tree Plantation areas are marked with blue stakes. To Retrieve your ball please enter the G.U.R. area at a 90' angle to your ball. Drop the ball at the nearest point of relief no nearer the hole or use the closest drop zone.

Hole 14th (West) It is permitted to take relief on either side of the penalty areas marked with red stakes or lines.

Relief under no penalty is permitted for abnormal ground condition on the West Front 9.

Full local rules are posted and updated on Local Rules noticeboard inside the pro shop.

ADDITIONAL INFO

Defibrillator is located on the 1st floor of the clubhouse.

Hole 8 is a "call-up hole". Please mark your ball when you arrive at the green and indicate to those on the tee that they can play.

Always play a provisional if you are uncertain of your ball's location.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY INSTRUCTIONS

(Includes & not limited to –standing water, fog, snow, electrical storm)

For, but not limited to, the listed reasons, it might be necessary to close the golf course/s or suspend play. A klaxon will be sounded to suspend play. If, however, the klaxon is not heard & the player believes they are at risk, the player is permitted to proceed under the provision of rule 6.8 & discontinue play.

KLAXON CODES

1 long blast – play suspended.

2 long blasts – play restarted.

Repeated long blasts – possible danger, players advised to leave the course immediately.

DRESS CODE

ON THE COURSE

- Sleeved shirts (Long or Short) with collars shall be always worn. Ladies shirts must have a collar & be appropriate for golf.
- Turtleneck tops with 2" collar & manufactured for golf wear are acceptable.
- Trousers /shorts must be tailored & suitable for golf. No Jeans.
- Only sports socks may be worn.
- Golf shoes or trainers must be worn.

CLUBHOUSE

- Smart Casual
- No hats to be worn inside the clubhouse.

DOGS

Weybrook Park does not allow dogs on the course.
