



Weybrook Park Golf Club Ltd Health and Safety at Work Act 1974

Policy Statement

Weybrook Park Golf Club Ltd recognises its statutory duties on employers, employees, visitors and sub-contractors under the Health and Safety at Work act 1974 –The management of Health and Safety Regulations 1999 and all other relevant acts and regulations.

To enable these statutory duties to be carried out, it is the policy of Weybrook Park Golf Club, so far as reasonably practicable, to prevent personal injury, damage to property and the environment.

To ensure that responsibilities for Health, safety, welfare and the environment are properly assigned and fulfilled at all levels.

Therefore the intention of Weybrook Park Golf Club Ltd, in so far as is reasonably practicable, to ensure that:

1. The provision and maintenance of plant, equipment and systems of work are safe and without risks to health and the environment.
2. Arrangements for use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances are safe.
3. Adequate information and training is available detailing the conditions and precautions necessary to secure the health, safety and welfare of all visitors and sub-contractors.
4. All necessary safety devices and protective equipment is available and used according to manufacturer's/suppliers instructions.
5. All Directors, Managers and Sub-contractors are responsible for ensuring that the policy is effectively implemented by carrying out risk assessments and making periodical checks as required by company procedures and deal with problems as they arise.
6. Every person involved will take necessary steps to protect the health, safety, welfare and environment of themselves and all other persons who may be affected by their acts and omissions.
7. The environment of all sub-contractors is safe and without risks to health and that adequate provisions are made for First Aid, welfare.

The Chairman, having overall responsibility for Health, Safety and Environmental issues and in Consultation with RPJ Associated Consultants Ltd, will ensure the policy is appraised and updated as required
